### MAKE A DIFFERENCE

In the fall of 2018, Lilly Endowment launched its seventh Giving Indiana Funds for Tomorrow (GIFT) initiative. Known for a long tradition of promoting community development by incentivizing contributions to endowment funds through matching grant challenges, the Endowment is especially fond of helping community foundations grow their unrestricted community funds.

During the GIFT VII matching period, PCCF was eligible to earn \$1.5 million from Lilly if we could raise that much from our community. We are delighted to report that, because of the overwhelming generosity of the people of Porter County, that challenge was met a full six months ahead of the December 31, 2020 deadline.

In all, 215 donors made contributions that qualified to earn matching money from Lilly. Of the 46 new funds that were established, 20 were community

funds that will forever benefit Porter County in the broadest possible sense by making flexible grant money available to meet the ever-changing needs and opportunities over time; 20 were designated to support a specific agency. There were also 4 donor advised funds and 2 field of interest funds started.



"Chris and I love the idea of a community fund because it provides the Foundation the flexibility to respond to sudden, often unpredictable events," said Mark Maassel who, along with his wife, Chris, started a community fund during GIFT VII. "We are living through an example right now with a sudden surge in demand at food pantries due to the pandemic. The Foundation will be able to use this fund FOREVER as such events and opportunities arise."

GIFT VII also included a component that provides funding to community foundations to develop and implement a project that will improve the community in some way. Here in Porter County, we'll be using this opportunity to launch a formal collaboration to expand the efforts of organizations providing programs and services to pregnant women and families with infants and toddlers. # PORTER COUNTY Emergency Response Fund

Think back to January when 2020 started like any other turn of the calendar. Who could have imagined the challenges lurking in wait? By March, our conversations routinely included words like pandemic, COVID, mask, social distance, sanitizer, test, Zoom, shut down, quarantine, work remotely, shelter-in-place, and e-learning. It quickly became apparent that communities across the country would face disruption on an imposing scale.

Here in Porter County, your Community Foundation and United Way joined forces to establish the We Are Porter County Emergency Response Fund to provide our residents with an efficient way to support the needs that were becoming apparent and urgent. Hundreds of caring folks quickly and generously responded to the tune of \$468,511.

To date, \$280,705 has been granted to organizations experiencing an increased need for their services and to help them acquire PPE and cleaning and disinfecting supplies to keep themselves and their clients safe. At the time of this writing, the virus is surging again. We stand ready to deploy additional funds to bolster our ability to care for our friends and neighbors. Your generosity makes this possible.
